



COVID-19 PROTOCOL

- BWR will follow all local and state guidelines for dance facilities, as directed by the CDC.
- Any dancers or dancers with family members who are unwell are not permitted to attend class. There must be NO signs or symptoms of COVID-19 within the past 14 days.
- Designated entrances and exits throughout the building will be labeled.
- Parent lobby will be closed indefinitely. Parents are permitted to walk children into the building, get them ready and off to class. At that point, parents must exit. There will be no lingering inside the building. We ask that parents of young children stay in our parking lot for the duration of your child's class. At the end of class, parents will enter to retrieve their children and leave the building immediately.
- Do not arrive more than 10 minutes before your child's class and please be prompt when picking up your child at the end of class.
- Upon entry to the building, each child will have their temperature taken before class begins. If a child's temperature is greater than 100.4, the child must go home and monitor symptoms.
- ALL PARENTS AND DANCERS AGE 5 AND UP WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR MASKS when inside the building. Masks are not required of dancers age 3-4, but it is highly recommended.
- All instructors and staff members will be wearing masks.
- Once registration and rosters are established, all parents will be required to download the Remind app. This will be our means of communication during classes, in the event we need to contact a parent.
- Please try to have your child use the restroom at home before arriving to class. If your child does need to use the restroom and needs assistance during class, you will be contacted via the Remind app and you will be permitted to enter the building to assist your child.
- All tuition payments MUST be paid either online or via the drop box outside Sharon's office. No in person payments will be permitted. Any questions can be made by phone or email.
- Our custodian, Jackie Bishop, will be on the premises each day classes are taking place. All studios and common places will be cleaned and sanitized each day. Ballet barres, light switches, door knobs and other highly touched areas will be cleaned between each class.
- Dancers are encouraged to bring their own hand sanitizer.
- There will be NO sharing of ANY belongings, including dance shoes and dance wear, food and drinks.
- There will be NO lost and found. Please write your dancer's name inside all of their dance shoes and belongings. If anything is left at the end of the night, we will have to discard it unless we know who it belongs to.

- **There will be markers separating dancers 6 feet apart in each studio to show where dancers will stand at the barre and in the center. Dancers must stay on their assigned markers at all times.**
- **Each studio will have a maximum number of markers to stand on. Once that number is fulfilled for each class, classes will be closed to additional enrollment.**
- **Instructors will stay 6 feet away from all dancers and will refrain from using tactile teaching methods.**
- **Regarding the Student Lobby, we want to prevent any excessive “hanging out.” If your dancer has a break in between classes, dancers MUST maintain distancing while in the student lobby. We will provide 6 feet markers in the student lobby and will utilize our front lobby for overflow, if necessary.**
- **Please limit the amount of belongings your dancer brings into the building. Only bring necessary dance shoes and items for that specific night. We plan to provide cubbies in each studio where your dancer’s belongings can be kept in order to prevent excess traffic through the student lobby.**
- **In addition to in-person classes, we are going to attempt to still provide some sort of online instruction.**
- **Upon registration, a COVID-19 waiver must be signed via the Parent Portal in order for your child to return to in person classes.**
